In fall 2023, the Senior Services Consortium of Ramsey County (now Meals on Wheels of Ramsey County/ MOWRC) entered into a strategic planning process with the aim of building on its impressive 50-year history by developing a three to five-year plan dedicated to supporting a collaborative of community-based Meals on Wheels programs as they deliver essential nutrition services to older adults, individuals with disabilities, and others in Ramsey County.

As a nonprofit membership organization, MOWRC is a convener of 8 member agencies that provide meals and other senior services in Ramsey County. The members include four social service providers serving residents within the City of St. Paul and four suburban school districts serving suburban Ramsey County residents.
